Translating challenging environments into workable plans

Productions in Africa can be shaped by terrain, weather, permissions, community protocols, roads, language, customs procedures, supplier reliability and the availability of specialist services. Plan Africa's value is not only arranging services - it is knowing where issues may appear and resolving them before they slow the shoot.

- Weather, terrain, road, access and field-condition guidance.
- Local customs, cultural sensitivities and community engagement protocols.
- Security, medical and emergency route planning where required.
- Daily field troubleshooting and decision support during production.
- Practical translation between international production expectations and local operating conditions.

Contracted support and logistics for African projects

Plan Africa can also provide non-film industry contracted support and logistics for organizations working on African projects. The same field intelligence, stakeholder fluency and practical coordination that support productions can be applied to research missions, NGO work, corporate field visits, infrastructure site work, impact projects and institutional assignments.

- Local partner identification, supplier sourcing and negotiation.
- Accommodation, transport, field movement and route planning.
- Guides, translators, local liaison officers and community engagement.
- Security, access, meeting coordination and contingency planning.
- Ground intelligence and operational briefings for project teams.



A practical operating model from brief to wrap

1. Brief and feasibility	Clarify creative intent, locations, schedule, risk tolerance, budget expectations and local constraints.
2. Scout and secure	Identify sites, assess access, engage owners, communities and authorities, and confirm workable options.
3. Build the ground plan	Develop schedules, permits, logistics, movement, accommodation, catering, crew, equipment and contingency plans.
4. Mobilize	Coordinate arrivals, customs, transport, crew, suppliers, location readiness and field base setup.
5. Support the shoot	Manage daily logistics, access, local liaison, translation, field issues, welfare and real-time problem-solving.
6. Close out and continue	Reconcile suppliers, complete paperwork, close locations, support re-export and prepare for future continuity.
Field principle Anticipate, prepare, translate and deliver - so production problems are solved before they become production delays.
